

Department of Infectious and Tropical Diseases, Zanjan University of Medical Sciences:

Educational goals and mission of the infectious department:

The general goal is to teach the common issues of infectious medicine at the levels of internship and assistantship. Due to the fact that the target group in this plan are stagers, interns and assistants.

the goals set at this level are mentioned:

The group has designed a written program for training, which will be mentioned in detail in the field of training program. According to the ministry's reference, Harrison's book for interns and Mendel's book, together with the articles of The New England Journal of Medicine and Clinical Infectious Diseases, are used for assistants to teach scientific and theoretical topics.

The distribution of the activities of the faculty members in the three departments of education - treatment - research is as follows:

training section :

Practical teaching: In addition to assistants, the infectious disease department has students at the level of trainees and interns in all months of the year. Students undergo an infectious disease training course in the clinical department. During this period, students have at least 6-7 days of training with each teacher. Clinical training is also held less often

The training program for medical students in the hospital has been organized before the start of the course

Educational planning is according to the opinion of the director of the infectious diseases group and the members of the group.

Morning report: Group members participate in the morning report during planning, and the specialist responsible for that day's training is required to attend the morning report. The report is held every morning at 8-9 in the presence of professors for 1 hour.

Round: Working round is done by each of the professors every day for about 2 hours on the patient's bed. Diagnostic measures and follow-up of patients will be carried out by the relevant residents and interns and the supervisor of the department. Teaching Round is managed by the faculty responsible for education.

Journal Club: According to the schedule, it will be held for 1 hour with the participation of all students. One of the professors is responsible for organizing and running the journal.

Classroom: Based on the titles of important and common diseases, it is formed after the round

Teaching theory courses: Infectious theoretical lessons (54 hours) are taught by all professors and each professor has 18 to 21 hours of theoretical lessons per semester. The theory unit is offered twice a year. Also, the theory unit in the midwifery and nursing school in Zanjan is conducted by the professors of the group.

Also, students from basic science groups such as microbiology, parasitology, etc. are present and taught in the infectious disease department on a rotating basis.

MedicalAdvice: Each member of the group is responsible for about 8 on-call per month. If necessary, they appear at the patient's bedside in the hospital. Ankal professors must be available 24 hours a day, and each on-call professor is responsible for conducting requested consultations at the city level (Dr. Beheshti - Ayatollah Mousavi - Waliasr hospitals)and is also responsible for other hospitals in the state

Supervision of theses: According to the university rules, each of the professors can supervise several general medicine and residency theses at the same time. For this purpose, it has formed an infectious diseases research group with priority on the endemic infectious diseases of the region. For this purpose, research priorities have been compiled. Research projects have been carried out or are being approved, limited to the population of certain areas of the province or the entire province. Also, several projects have been carried out or are being carried out in cooperation with other states.

Treatment section:

All members are full-time and are serving in special clinics affiliated with the university.
